WHAT IS A CSA? Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a great way to buy local, seasonal produce & other farm products directly from a farmer.

HOW DOES A CSA WORK? Purchase a "share" in our farm, and, depending on which share you choose, you'll receive a box of meat, eggs, yogurt or fresh baked bread 13 times. Unlike our vegetable CSA, the weeks do not have to be consecutive and with 7 days notice you can skip a week or two for vacation or double up for a party.

- 16 oz Plain Sheep Yogurt

EGG SHARE \$65

- 1 Dozen Weekly

- 1 Large Loaf and a breakfast item (muffins, Scones, Coffee Cake etc.)
